

# TEAM APPCO DRIVER WINS



Team APPCO's Josh Brown takes an impressive win over the pack, leading by a straight away. Sunday afternoon Brown raced his APPCO powered offset chassis on the 1/10 mile clay bull ring of Bryant Speedway just north of Portland, Indiana. Josh started out in practice with a kart capable of finishing mid-pack at best. Overcoming a poor handling chassis with years of tuning experience, Josh was able to finish 4<sup>th</sup> in his first heat in which he started on the tale. Josh won his second heat which earned the number 46 kart of Browns a starting spot on the outside pole for the main event. Josh had his work cut out for him, starting on the outside pole to Lance Mitchey in the number 10 kart. Mitchey (the track owner's son) was very fast, winning the first heat and finishing not far behind, was Brown in the second. The Green flag was dropped in the main event and the APPCO powered 46 stayed nose to nose with the number 10 of Mitchey for more than two laps with Brown prevailing to the lead and eventually pulling away with impressive speed on the 11 degree banked track. Josh took the checkered flag with an entire strait away lead over the pack and bringing home another win for Team APPCO.
